- Listening, Reading, Writing, and Speaking sections can be taken individually or in combination.

Structure & Content

- understand important information about people, their likes and dislikes, and everyday activities in short conversations when speakers speak slowly and clearly

How can I improve my English?
Here are some suggestions:

- listen to short conversations with speakers talking about everyday activities, such as work and school, or what they do and don't like
- try to focus on the important information about people, places, objects, and activities in longer conversations
- listen to radio programs, TV shows, and online videos where the visuals help you understand what people are saying
