About the Exam

- Burlington VTest English for Schools: Ages 11-15 is an online exam for young learners from Pre-A1 to C1.
- Results are mapped to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).
- Question difficulty adapts to each learner's performance through multi-stage adaptive testing.
- Listening, Reading, Writing, and Speaking sections can be taken individually or in combination.

Why Ages 11-15?

- Burlington VTest for Schools offers separate exams for ages 7-10 and 11-15.
- These age groups reflect CEFR guidance for assessing young learners and teenagers at different stages of development.

Structure & Content

- Engaging, age-appropriate tasks based on familiar real-world situations.

- A1 to B2 scores provide more precise information about learners' abilities.
